Progressing the Agenda of the Economic Audit Committee (EAC)

IMPORTANT BRIEFING FOR WACOSS MEMBERS (July 2010)

The Economic Audit Committee was formed by the WA Government to examine ways to deliver better outcomes for the people of WA. As the peak body for the community services sector, WACOSS is heavily involved in representing the sector in EAC processes, as well as engaging the sector to ensure that the views put forward by WACOSS truly represent all facets of the community services sector.

WACOSS has compiled a short briefing note to inform members of important details and developments in relation to the implementation of EAC recommendations, including:

- the development of a new Partnership Forum between government and the community sector;
- Steering and Working Groups to support the Partnership Forum to progress a range of agendas significant to our sector;
- the creation of a new public EAC website so that the work being undertaken by the EAC agenda is transparent and accessible;
- WACOSS Sector engagement, including WACOSS Regional Consultations occurring in July 2010;
