Initiative 3:

Provide scholarships for digital skills credentials

Background:

Scholarships will offer participants an accredited digital skills qualification through a registered training organisation. This qualification will be available after the end of the WA Digital Inclusion Project.



We will:

- Explore digital skill qualifications that already exist.
- Engage with community services and training organisations to develop the program.
- Work with our partner organisations to find the best-fit approach.
- Invite applications and enrol participants.
- Create communities of practice where participants can share information and support
- Work with a monitoring and evaluation provider to measure the impact of our work.





Ability:

These scholarships will help people improve their digital skills and support others to do the same confidently and safely.

Outcomes:

- Community members will gain digital skill qualifications for future job and volunteer opportunities.
- A registered training organisation will offer an accredited digital skills training course to the wider community in the future.

In this initiative, we will work with partner organisations and registered training organisations to find the best training approach.
